Peter Clarke is the Senior Vice President of Electric Engineering and Emergency Preparedness for Eversource Energy (Eversource or the Company). In this role, Clarke is responsible for designing, implementing and leading a new centralized Engineering organization that will leverage synergies across all of Eversource Electric Operations throughout the Company's service territory in Connecticut, Massachusetts and New Hampshire.
